Woodside Equine Clinic recommends a comprehensive equine *Wellness Program* to assure the best care for your horse. There are two levels to choose from. Should a wellness program not be chosen for your horse, it is still our recommendation that every horse receive an annual physical examination, dental exam, and vaccines as recommended below.
